Mark Hunyadi, Professor of Moral and Political Philosophy at the Catholic University of Leuven (Belgium) and Associate Professor at the Chair, will explain the principles of his unified theory of trust, and how it applies to the **digital world**.

This will be followed by a multidisciplinary discussion on law, economics and network security with the co-hosts of the VP-IP Chair: Claire Levallois-Barth, Lecturer of Laws at Télécom Paris, Patrick Waelbroeck, Professor of Economics at Télécom Paris and Maryline Laurent, Professor of Computer Sciences at Télécom SudParis.
